## Enhanced Safety Measures That You And Your Loved One Deserve

- **Covid Caregiver Testing:** All our caregivers are tested for COVID-19 (once) before any new case starts. After caregivers initial first test by SLHC, any additional Covid testing will be done by client request, at a cost of \$60 per test to the client-for client's in Washington DC and Montgomery County.
- **PPE for Staff:** All caregivers are required to wear PPE while caring for our clients. We provide our caregivers with proper PPE.
- **Clients: New off-site clients, residing in a private home, will be gifted with a no contact thermometer as an added safety measure. Free of charge.** We ask that clients wear a cloth mask.
- **Staff Self-Screening:** Employees are required to complete two daily 6 point electronic self-assessments recommended by CDC while working.
